Each year, Seton Youth Shelters services are provided without charge to help over 15,000 youths, from age 9 to 21, through our shelter, counseling, street outreach and in-school programs (ages served are dependent upon program).

Shelter is provided for up to 22 at-risk youth ages 9 to 18 at our two shelters in Virginia Beach, where they stay an average of 20 days and receive daily counseling as well as food, clothing, medical assistance and much needed support. Our internal cost for this service is approximately \$125.00 per youth, per day, but we are able to provide these services without charge because of the kindness and generosity of our community.
