Our policemen and women haven't received merit-based pay raises since 2007/2008. Now city leaders are threatening to raise the cost of their healthcare benefit by around 8% – which amounts to a pay *cut*.

City leadership is signaling a 2% budget cut overall for the police department. Meanwhile, the City Council continues to explore expensive projects (light rail, sports arenas, etc.), giving no thought to the added responsibilities and workload that will be borne by those who have to police them.

In the coming months, budget decisions will profoundly affect the lives of our police officers. Let's stand up for our public servants when they need our support.
